SATTVA



In Hindu philosophy, the sattva concept refers to a way of existence that is associated with goodness, positivity, serenity, balance, peace and virtuosity; in the pieces of the Sattva collection, which includes a chair, a multipurpose stool and a side table, this inspiration is reflected in the balance of two colors -natural and black-, in the flowing lines and weaves, and even in its own vegetal materiality, since they are made entirely of rattan.














PERLA CASTAÑÓN
